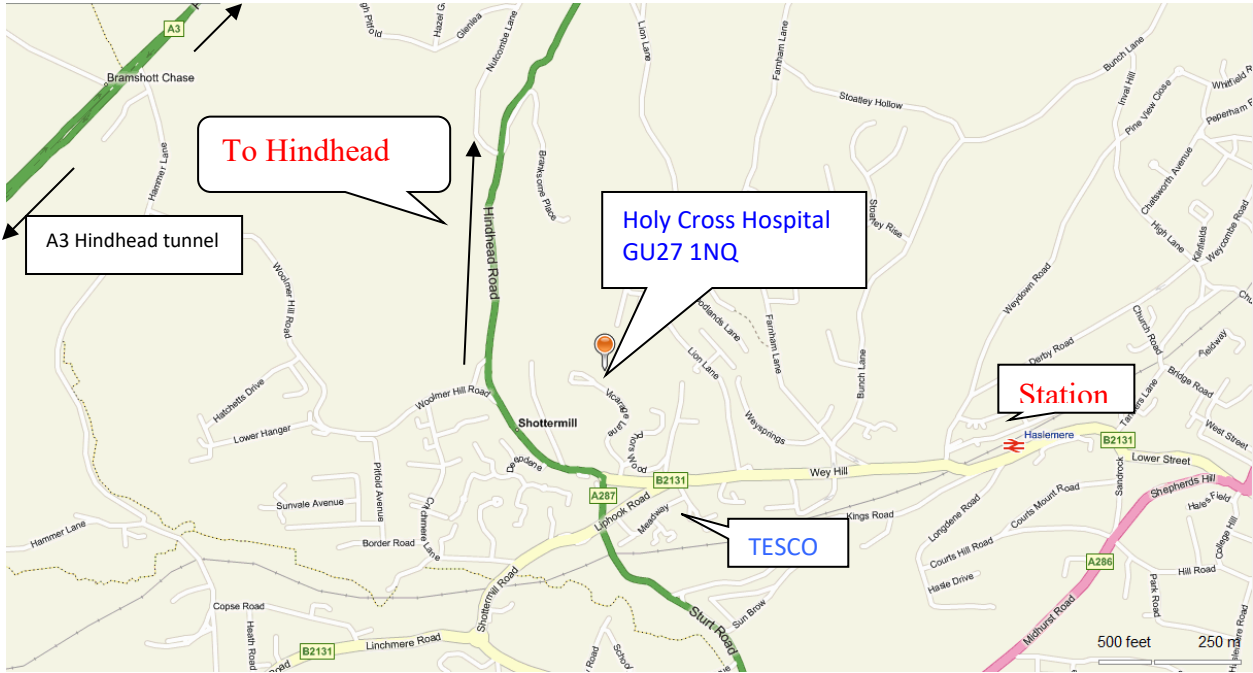
Confirmation of booking

By Car

If travelling from London or Portsmouth on the A3, turn off on the A287 at the Hindhead traffic lights, following signposts for Haslemere. Descend a steep and winding hill for approximately 2 miles. The hospital drive entrance is on the left, 100 metres after Church Road, a right hand turn signposted to Midhurst (this is Church Road, Shottermill, it should not be confused with Church Road in Haslemere town centre).

By Train

Haslemere station is 20 minutes walk and has regular services to Guildford, London and Portsmouth.

By Bus

The following Stagecoach bus routes pass close to the Hospital, all of them also pass the train station:

- **No 18 - Aldershot to Haslemere via Bordon**
- **No 18X - Haslemere to Alton College (college days only)**
- **No 19 - Aldershot to Haslemere via Churt**
- **No 70 - Guildford to Midhurst**
